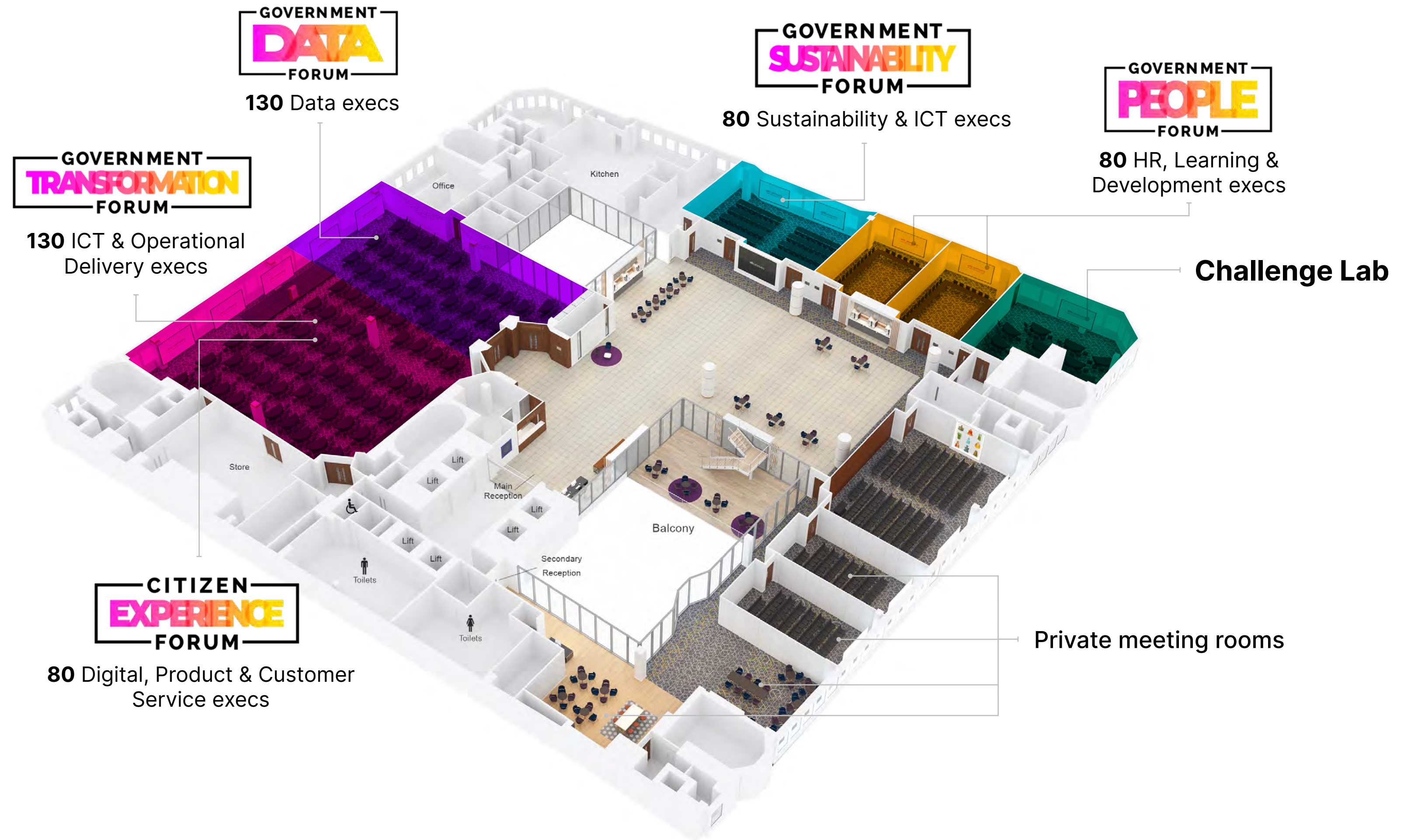
Global transformation leaders are coming to London

How the Discussion Tables Work

1

Choose a Discussion Table topic (see full list on page 8)

2

You will Co-Host that Discussion Table alongside another senior government executive, and an expert from industry – for four 30-minute sessions

3

Before the conference – 20-minute Zoom call with your Discussion Table co-hosts to talk through your collective experience of the topic, and approach to engaging government delegates

4

At the conference – you will meet 5 different UK civil servants in each of the four sessions to explore the Discussion Table's topic. You will then be free to move to any other Discussion Table for the fifth and final session of the day

Challenge Lab

Delegates volunteer specific areas of concern ahead of the Summit – and then engage their peers to crowd-source potential solutions in a series of government-led discussions in our unique and highly regarded Challenge Lab



How the Challenge Lab Works

1

Delegates submit 'Challenge Statements' during registration (voluntary)

2

You receive an aggregated report of these Challenge Statements – giving you insight into the concerns and priorities of our government attendees ahead of the conference

3

At the conference, 10 UK Government Departments discuss their challenges in the Challenge Lab – which you are free to join when not involved in co-hosting your Discussion Table

4

This is part of our commitment to creating an inclusive conference with space for execution-oriented civil servants to be a part of the wider discussions
